The Welcome & Farewell Program 2025 stood as a testament to student leadership, collaboration, and the vibrant campus life, creating lasting memories for everyone involved.



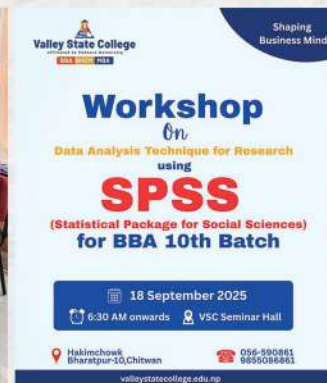
## Workshop on Data Analysis Techniques Using SPSS Successfully Concluded

Valley State College congratulates all participating students for their efforts and achievements and thanks the faculty and evaluators for their valuable guidance throughout the process.

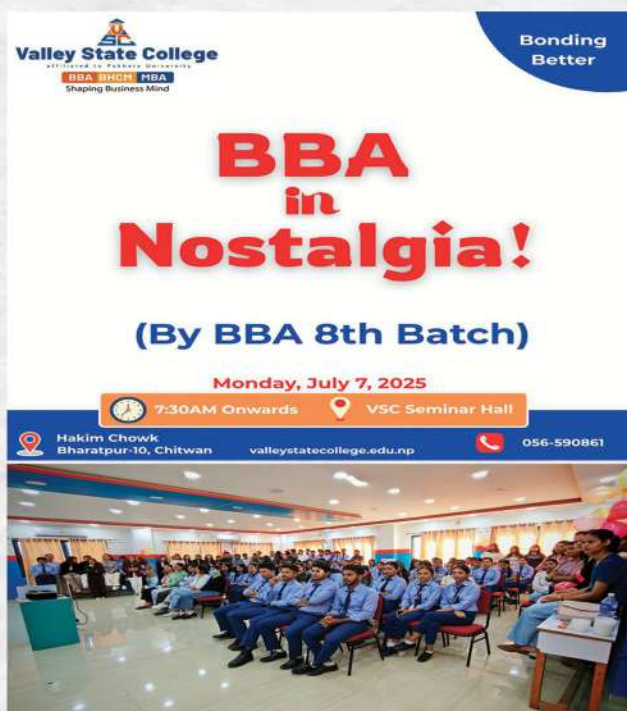


## BBA Farewell Celebration: A Journey of Memories and Gratitude

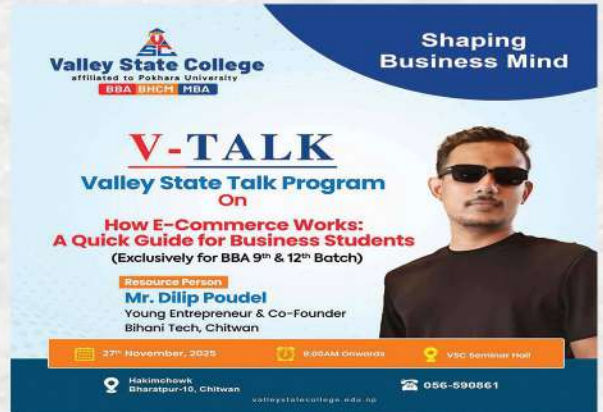
## E-Commerce Awareness Session to BBA 9th & 12th Batch

The session ended successfully, leaving students inspired and enriched with valuable insights for their academic and professional growth.



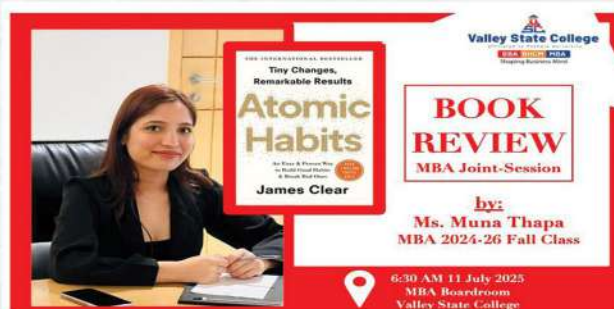
## MBA Joint Session: Engaging Book Reviews by Students

These sessions greatly contributed to fostering critical thinking and inspired meaningful conversations among students, enriching their overall learning experience at Valley State College.

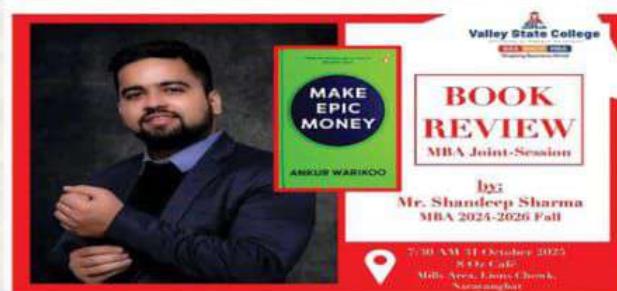


## From Mindset to Millions: Sandeep Sharma Reviews Make Epic Money
