BBA 13th Batch Gains Industry Exposure through Visit to CG Industrial Park

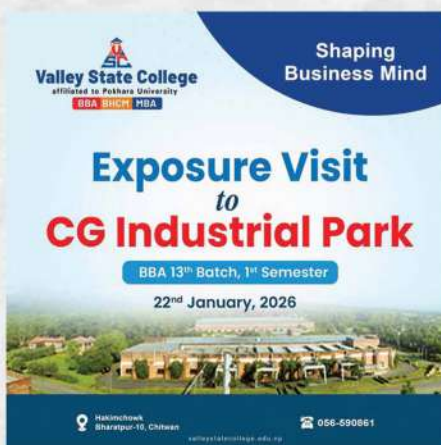
